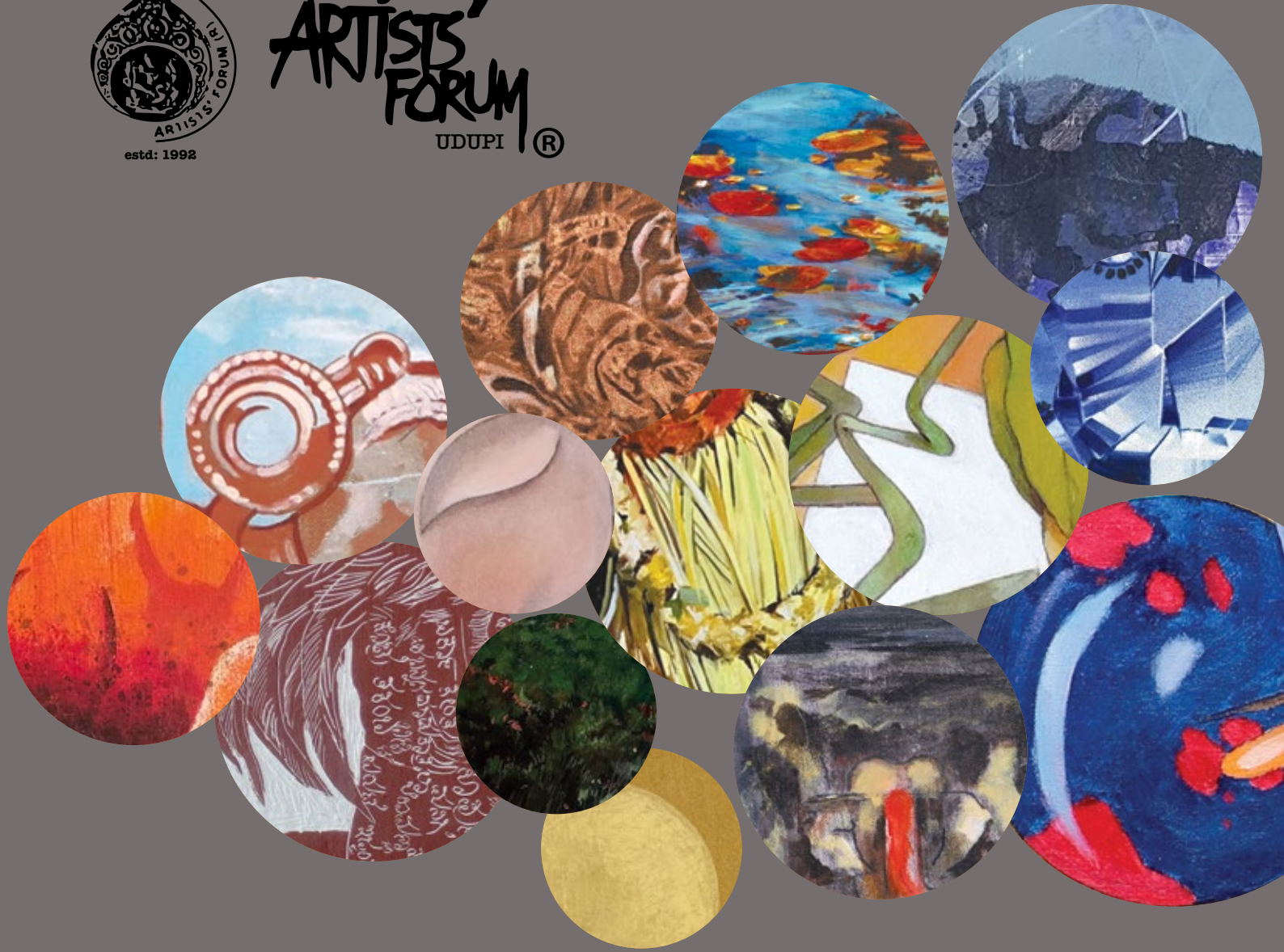

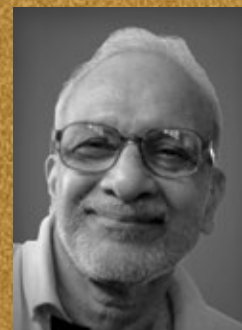

## **AS I LOOK AT IT .....**

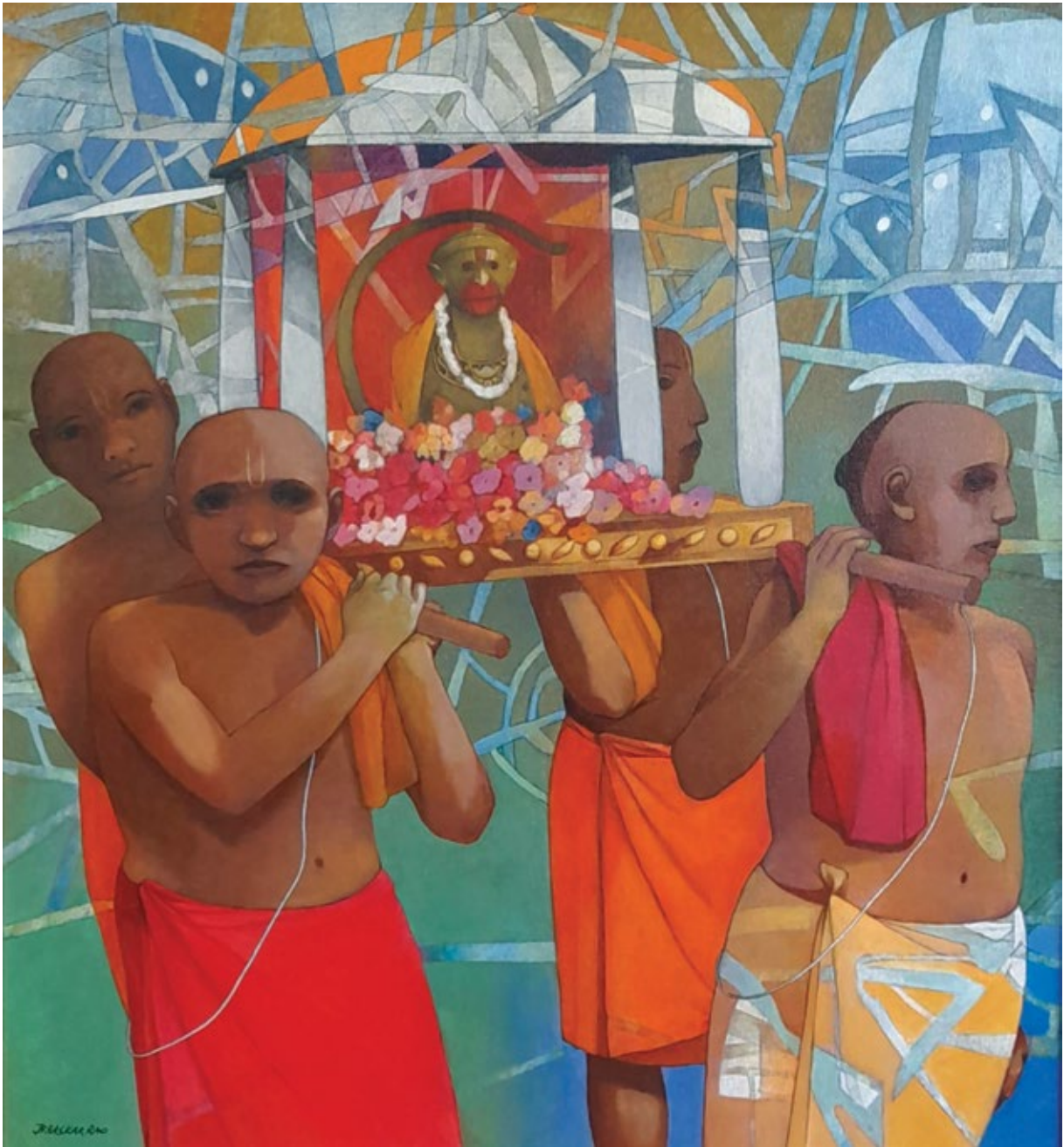

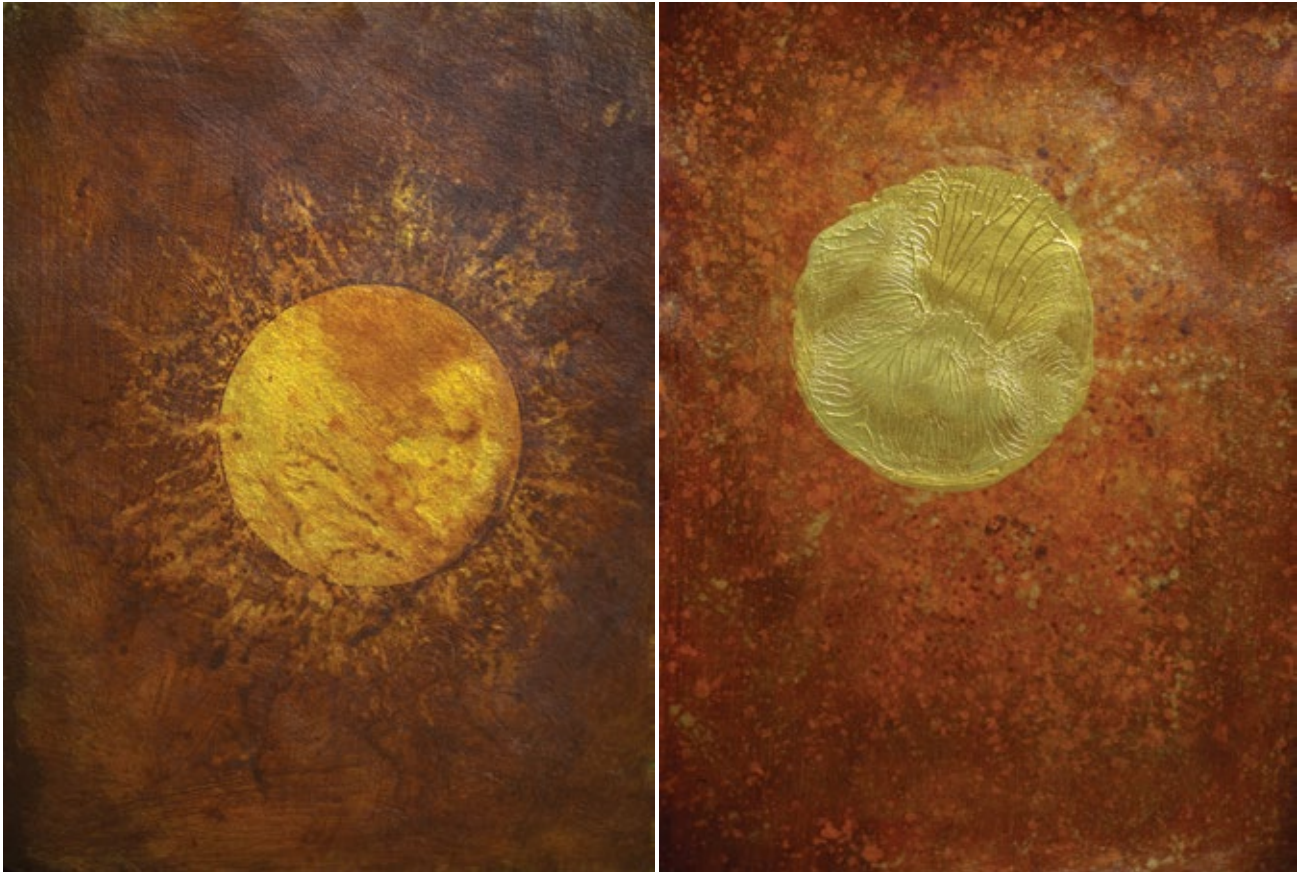
